



# 60 YEARS OF HISTORY



THE PORTES DU SOLEIL IS FIRST AND FOREMOST THE STORY OF A GROUP OF FRIENDS WHO, OVER 60 YEARS AGO, HAD A DREAM, THE DREAM OF A HUGE FRANCO SWISS SKI AREA LINKED BY SKI LIFTS.

This dream came true in 1964: a giant 3m by 3m 1:10,000 scale model of the future cross-border domain was presented to the general public at the Lausanne World Exhibition.

For the record

The project presented in Lausanne in 1964 was initially entitled the "Haute Route des Familles", in reference to the famous Chamonix-Zermatt crossing. in reference to the famous

Chamonix-Zermatt crossing.

Not a name with enough media coverage for Jean Vuarnet, the Olympic medal-winning ski racer from Morzine-Avoriaz. A fervent promoter of the idea of a linked domain, Jean took part in a meeting at the Grand Paradis Carnotzet in 1965, and went round the table to see what proposals had been put forward. Only the Swiss Gustave Trombert from Val d'Illiez had a proposal.

# **Development of the** domaine

In the years that followed, the project took shape with the gradual development of cross-border links.

The first was installed in 1956. Pierre Béteille, a Pyrenean adopted by Châtel, built the first cross-border lift: he extended the Coq lift with the Corbeau lift. The Super-Châtel sector is now linked to Morgins. By staying on the slopes, skiers could now move from one country to another without leaving their skis.

# **Skiing without borders is born!**

The Champéry-Avoriaz link via Chavanette confirmed the vision of the pioneers. In 1968, Téléchampéry built a fixed-grip double chairlift at Chavanette to provide

a link with the French resort of Avoriaz. At the same time, Avoriaz embarked on the construction of a ski lift, which was completed at the end of the summer of 1968.

### The two sides are connected!

The opening of Chavanette has opened up new possibilities for skiers: a magnificent route that provides access to the famous "Mur Suisse",

> the steepest runs the Subsequently, links developed. The original vision is gradually becoming a tangible reality. Les Portes du Soleil, a group of 12 resorts (7 in France and 5 in Switzerland) offering skiers a huge cross-border Alpine area with endless possibilities: 600km of skiing accessible via 208 lifts.

> Always a visionary, the Portes du Soleil was also quick to understand that the serious mountain biking segment was going to become a major

growth area for summer tourism. Indeed, for some mountain bikers, the pleasure comes exclusively from the downhill. In 1995, Le Pléney opened its gondola lift to mountain bikers and developed a dedicated track. Avoriaz, Châtel, Champéry, Les Crosets, Les Gets, Morgins and Morzine offer worldclass Bikeparks.

The UCI (International Cycling Union) has confirmed the region's appeal by organising the Mountain Bike World Championships in Les Gets in 2004 and 2023, and in Champéry in 2011. The Swiss resort will host them again in 2025!

# The largest cross-border e-bike network - Try it and you'll love it!

A pioneer in electric mountain biking, Portes du Soleil has been using electrically-assisted bikes since 2014! The ski area now offers routes specifically signposted for this type of cycling. The 12 resorts are working together to offer suitable routes without fear of the uneven terrain. There are also **Bosch recharging points** (free of charge) dotted around the resort, making it easy for touring hikers to recharge their batteries. This network of linked trails and all the associated infrastructure and services make the Portes du Soleil the largest cross-border e-bike network.

# High-profile international events

The Portes du Soleil is gearing up for an exceptional year in 2024 with a sporting calendar packed with events. The resort will once again be pulsating to the rhythm of what promises to be the biggest mountain biking event of the season!

The Portes du Soleil Mountain Bike Tour is an 80-kilometre ebike tour (available in Enduro format for the more sporty) that offers a different way of discovering the villages. Departing from one of the 12 French-Swiss resorts in the Portes du Soleil area (your choice), the route has been designed to resemble a safari. As you pass from one village to the next - from Les Gets to Morzine, via Avoriaz, Champéry, Châtel and Montriond - you'll discover all the points of interest along the way: hundred-year-old mountain chalets, exceptional flora and fauna, enchanting waterfalls... and all of this, set against exceptional panoramas: the majestic **Dents du Midi** and Lake Geneva!

A dozen or so lifts along the Alpine route, equipped to transport mountain bikes, will take you over the most difficult climbs and propel you up 7,000 metres of ascent and descent and some 1,000 metres of ascent and descent, giving this tour its enduro character. For the more energetic, there is a variant at the top of Châtel that takes in Torgon on the Swiss side.

# THE ADVENTURE STARTS HERE!

### 9.00am Départure of Châtel

After a coffee on the terrace, head for the Super Châtel gondola (in the centre of the village) when it opens at 9.00am. It's going to be a long day!

Thanks to our Portes du Soleil lift pass, we'll have access to all the open lifts in the area.

After just a few pedal strokes, we crossed the Swiss border. A path takes us to Lac de Conche, then the Corbeau sector, with its sumptuous landscapes and cows welcoming us to Swiss soil.

### 9.40am Arrival at Lac de Morgins

We skirt the shores of Lac de Morgins before arriving in the centre of the village of the same name. From here, we take the Morgins cable car, a new, modern and fast facility.

After a short, sweaty climb, we arrive at the Route du Lait. A fabulous sight awaits us: the Dents du Midi face us in all their majesty.



# 2.15 Bikepark, Les Gets

Time to test ourselves in the bikepark! After the Tour du Golf, the Ecureuils green trail takes us towards Les Gets. These few shapely and fun banked turns are perfect for getting our legs under us. In Les Gets, we take the Chavannes chairlift, which gives us the chance to ride for a while on the XCO World Cup track, which will be the last event before the Olympics. A blue track this time takes us through the forest, back towards Morzine. We cross the village to the Super Morzine cable car. From the Zore chairlift, we can admire the technical prowess of some of the riders on the Avoriaz bike park.



We cross the Crêtes de Zore in Avoriaz. Arriving at the route de la Joux Verte, we plunge into a new bike park trail. The Goat, a natural blue trail with a few roots, takes us to Les Lindarets. From here we return to Châtel via the last chairlift of the tour: Chaux Fleurie.

We follow the banks of the Dranse and cross the Parc des Dérêches. This is the place to be for all the family. There's a whole host of activities on offer, including horse riding, archery and a fitness trail... Then we arrive in the centre of Morzine, where mountain biking reigns supreme. The streets are teeming with riders on their dusty bikes. We then head for the Pléney gondola to reach Les Gets.

### 4.30pm End of the day!

All that's left is to take the road back down to the centre of Châtel and enjoy a cold beer in a local bar.

# FRIDAY 28 JUNE 2024

Bikes loaded on the bike rack, equipment in the panniers, repair kits and a few beers in the boot, everything's ready! The Pass'Portes du Soleil MTB is the annual event for this group of friends from Obernai in Alsace, and they wouldn't miss it for the world. It's off to Châtel! After about 4 hours on the road, Pierre, Antoine and Julien finally saw the mountain. This is it!

As always, we meet at La Godille for a pint of Mont-Blanc to kick off the weekend. Back at the flat, a final check of the bikes and equipment. Everyone has their identity cards and summons. Tomorrow morning we'll have to get up early for another memorable day of mountain biking.

# SATURDAY 29 JUNE 2024

86.38am The alarm goes off. We have a quick breakfast, check our equipment one last time and get ready to leave the flat. Pierre realises he's forgotten his gloves... We head for the pack depot, which opens at 97.38am. his gives us a chance to get our legs moving and warm up a bit.

Once the packs and gifts have been collected, everyone puts their number plate on their bike, their wristband on their wrist and slips their pass into their pocket. Now it's off to the start at the Super Châtel cable car!

First stop for a portrait at the Photossports spot. After a few turns on the pedals, the group of three friends crossed the border into Switzerland. Bells, cows, green grass, the red and white flag: there's no doubt about it, this is it! They then discover the new Morgins cable car

at Les Crosets. They quench their thirst and set off again quickly. They already know the route well, but they can't get enough of the views of the Dents du Midi from this sector.

It's around 10.00am when they arrive in Champéry. It's still a bit early for the raclette, but they need a little break, especially Julien, who has spent more time leaning against the bar than he has on his mountain bike down the slopes of Mont Sainte Odile this year...

After swallowing a few morsels of cheese and charcuterie, the group set off again to reach a not-to-be-missed point on the route: Lac Vert. WOW! A breathtaking landscape and a natural single that we always enjoy. Everyone was starting to get hungry, and just as well, the tartiflette was on its way! All of a sudden, Antoine's chain breaks... He's lucky, he'll be able to stop at the Mavic assistance stand MANIC in Lindarets. For the tartiflette break, we take our time and enjoy! What's more, the musicians are there to set the mood.

Once the team has had their refreshments and the bikes are ready to go, we're off again. This afternoon it's bikepark time! We pass through Morzine, Les Gets, then Morzine again. One sharp bend follows another and the sensations are there! Stop off in Morzine for dessert: the famous chocolate fondue ... Then it's on to Avoriaz and the Crêtes de Zore, then back to Les Lindarets. From there, the three friends will be able to get back to their starting station, but they'll have to pedal a bit more. HOP One last stop at the Châtel bike park and they're off again.

As usual, they had a memorable day on the Pass'Portes du Soleil MTB. They were tired, but they were all smiles. The three friends stopped off at the refreshment point to toast their great adventure

They then took the opportunity to visit the Mountain Bike Show. There were lots of beautiful bikes, textiles, accessories and, of course, the official shop! Pierre, whose hands were beginning to ache, found some gloves at ANNOZ Julien, tired from the day's activities, found comfort at the physiotherapists' stand. As for Antoine, he went to BOSCH exceed. to check out the latest products.

Tomorrow, the three friends will be taking advantage of the day to test some bikes at the show. Antoine spotted a *Lyke* from *HINDINE* that caught his eye. The test tracks at Super Châtel will give him the chance to try out this mountain bike in real conditions.

They will then go and discover the various activities at the show specially designed for the **20th anniversary of the Pass'Portes du Soleil MTB** , including a trip back in time through an exhibition of vintage bikes. Finally, they'll be able to buy a few souvenirs from the official shop before heading home with their heads full of beautiful images.

Gravel, a discipline halfway between road biking and mountain biking, is attracting more and more fans.

And why is that? First and foremost, because of the versatility and freedom it offers.

Roads, tracks, paths of varying degrees of difficulty: you can go almost anywhere on a gravel bike.

These 100% mountain gravel routes will take you over some of the most beautiful Alpine passes on wild roads and paths. Over more than 50 km, you'll climb between 1,580 m and 2,190 m of ascent and descent over

legendary passes such as the Col de Bassachaux, the Col des Portes du Soleil and the Col de Recon. The routes are suitable for both speed enthusiasts and those looking for adventure.

Morzine will be the scene of the Spartan Ultra World Championship & Trifecta Weekend 2024, from Friday 05 to Sunday 07 July.

Spartan, the world leader in obstacle racing, has established itself as a sporting discipline in its own right, one of the most complete physical activities, a mix of trail running and crossfit.

Since its first edition in 2017, the Spartan Ultra de Morzine has been described by athletes as the most demanding: a positive vertical drop of almost 4,000 m D+, natural elements and obstacles to overcome: the climb up a river, the vertiginous ascent of the Pointe de Nyon, the crossing of a high altitude lake, a jump into a waterfall, which are added to the 60 obstacles that punctuate the **50km** race.

The best finish in less than 7 hours, but the majority of participants take on more than 10 hours of intense effort.


# **Alta Lumina**


